CREATIVE TEAM BIOGRAPHIES

Kaaron Briscoe is a Brooklyn based theater artist with an MFA from ART/MXAT/IATT at Harvard University. She works as a writer, director, and performer. As a playwright, her work has been featured by the Classical Theater of Harlem, Project Y, Inviolent Theater, and others. Her most recent short play, *Lost and Found*, is being performed at the Downtown Live Festival, a collaboration between En Garde Arts, The Tank and the Downtown Alliance. Her play, *Tallahassee*, was a semi-finalist for the O'Neill Playwright's Conference. A native of New Orleans, Kaaron is an accomplished actor with over 30 years of experience. She has performed on stages in London and Moscow, as well as on screen. She often collaborates with Little Lord theater company and the Working Theater. She has directed for various organizations around New York, as well as for the Playwright's Center in Minnesota. Kaaron was a 2015 fellow of Target Margin Theater's Institute. She is a member of AEA, SAG-AFTRA, and the Dramatists' Guild. She is also a proud member of the 52nd Street Project.

ABOUT MAGIC IN PLAIN SIGHT

Target Margin Theater presents a new edition of *Magic in Plain Sight* from May 7 to June 19. *Magic in Plain Sight* is comprised of *Now Go and Act Accordingly*, a new work created under the direction of David Herskovits, and a series of one-week artist residencies with showings at their conclusion. The public events are designed for a limited number audience members who safely watch from the sidewalk.

All of the artists engaged with creating *Magic in Plain Sight* responded to the same starting point: Gathering. We asked ourselves, How do we gather now? How can we come together in celebration, joyfully? How can we look toward a future of change, and begin to build it here today?

Target Margin Theater will also be designating select performances of *Go Now Go and Act Accordingly* to its partner community organizations in Sunset Park. To deepen the engagement, Target Margin will conduct a workshop for the community organization in advance of these performances.
